# LAUFZETTEL / TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

You will receive a so-called 'Laufzettel'. This document is very important because you need it filled out by the professors of your courses to get your transcript of records at the end of your exchange semester.

In the last week of the semester, you will need to ask each of your professors to fill in your grades and ECTS for the exams you have taken on this Laufzettel. Afterwards you will need to submit it to the student exchange coordinator in the DMI International Office.

# ACADEMIC CALENDAR AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

The main holidays during the semesters in Hamburg are Easter and Christmas, and the university is closed for these holidays. In May there are also a couple of public holidays on which the university is closed.





## **CAFETERIA**

The cafeteria serves lunch from 11:30 am to 2:30 pm.

The daily menu can be viewed on a monitor in front of the cafeteria. Meals containing pork are marked with a pig's head; dishes containing alcohol can be identified by a little bottle beside the name. All meals can be paid for with cash or with the HAW Hamburg chip card. To use this service, you will have to load money onto your card. A machine that allows you to load the card by paying with bank notes is located next to the cafeteria.


