Based on the recognition of your academic achievements you will receive an individually customised study plan. In combination with career-oriented qualification, counselling and intensive coaching, you will acquire a Bachelor's degree from HAW Hamburg in a shortened period of study and precisely the key skills that offer you

the best prospects for a successful entry into the labour market as an engineer or computer scientist.

The study programme [BachelorUP - For a successful career start](#) extends over two years and consists of the following modules:

- 2 semesters of study in a suitable Bachelor's degree programme to expand your study-specific expertise
- Multilingual specialised tutorials in small groups
- High practical component through work experience as a student trainee in a company
- Practical semester and Bachelor's thesis in cooperation with a company
- Career orientation and career planning

With the KINEA project, HAW Hamburg opens up educational opportunities for people with personal experience of migration in line with their abilities by focussing on resources and skills.
